DRESS CODE

- Volunteers are encouraged to wear their group logo branded clothing to promote their organization.
- Dress Comfortably and wear tennis shoes.
- Shirts must have sleeves.
- Consider bringing sweat pants, or a jacket for changing weather.
- Consider bringing along sunscreen, sunglasses, and ear protection, if desired.
- Note: there is no storage available for personal belongings.

CONCESSIONS STAFF

- Lunch, snacks, and water will be provided to all volunteers.

- No Smoking or Vaping on the CVAS25 Grounds.
